SAINT LOUIS SOCCER AMONG TOP 10 IN 1996 ATTENDANCE

Saint Louis University's men's soccer team was third in the nation in average attendance among NCAA Division I institutions during the 1996 season. The Billikens drew 2,244 fans per game to the Anheuser-Busch Conference & Sports Centre for their home schedule last fall.

Billikens first-year head coach Bob Warming looks forward to the support. "When I was on the other sideline, I always noticed that Saint Louis games were like a big, family reunion," Warming said. "Everyone seems to know

one another, and it's just a fun atmosphere. It's the type of situation that is attractive to players and motivates them to perform and entertain."

The Billikens were fourth in the nation in average attendance during the 1994 season. Saint Louis averaged 2,015 fans per game for eight home matches.

Virginia led the nation in total attendance as the Cavaliers drew 38,685 for 15 home dates. The top 10 in average attendance follow:
