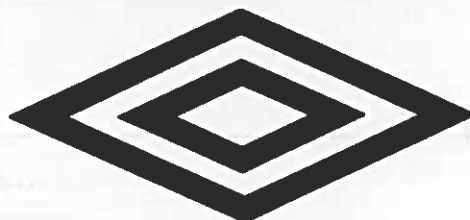

Billiken Bits

--Three Saint Louis University players have received four Robert R. Herman trophies as collegiate soccer's best player during a five-year span. Al Trost in 1969 and 1970, Mike Seerey in 1972 and Dan Counce in 1973. No award was given in 1971.

--The Billikens have produced 57 professional players, three professional coaches and two players in the National Football League.

--Saint Louis University has produced 15 first-team All Americans, 11 second-team All Americans and 16 honorable-mention All Americans. Current Billiken head coach Joe Clarke received honorable-mention recognition in 1975.
